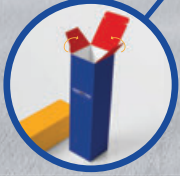

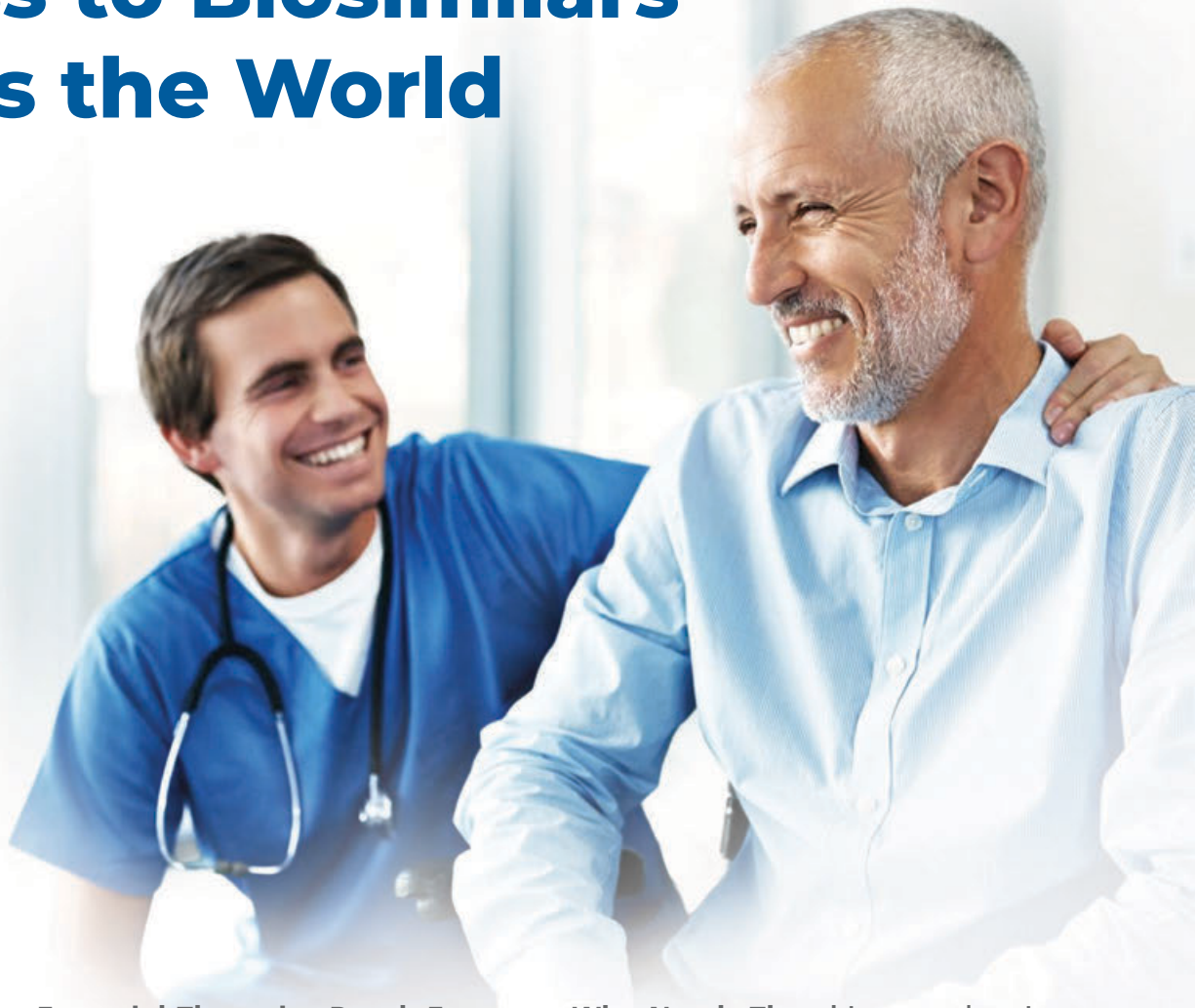

Kenya BioVax Institute is a state-owned organization that was incorporated in 2021 to manufacture, package and commercialize vaccines and other health products and technologies.

This was informed by a feasibility study that was conducted in 2020 which sought to understand if the country could manufacture its own vaccines to fill the gap when it exits the support of GAVI in 2029. Based on this study, the Government of Kenya (GoK) committed to build its own capacity for the production of human vaccines to ensure long-term sufficiency in its immunization agenda.

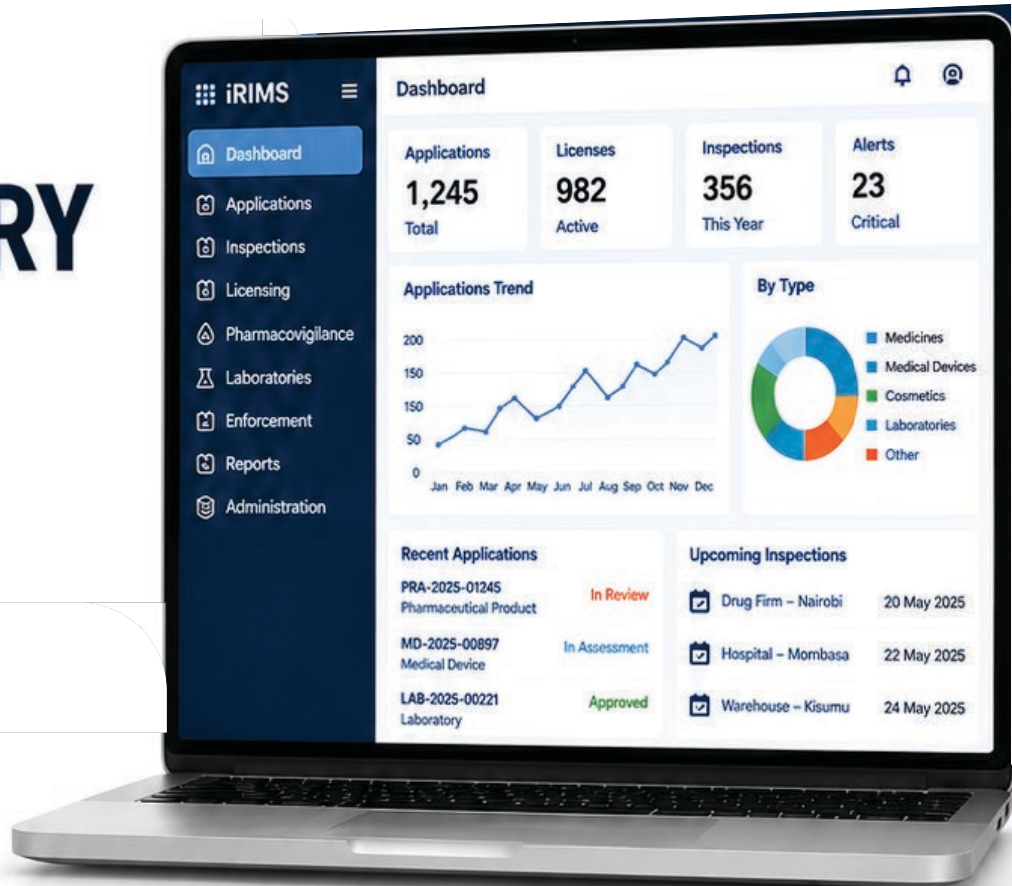
